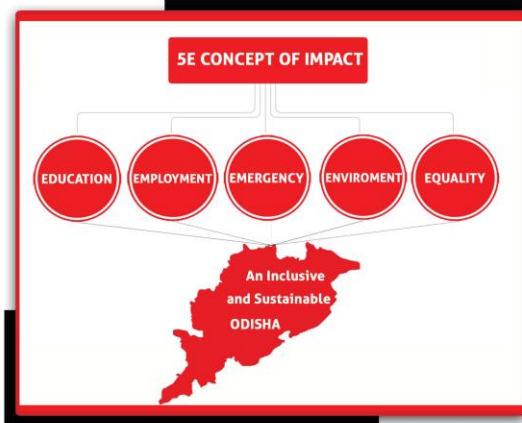

## EMPLOYMENT - KAMA DHAMA (A SKILL TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT GENERATION PROJECT).

Decent work for all is the goal of Project Kaamo-Dhaamo therefore it provides job oriented and entrepreneurship skill trainings to the disadvantaged youths of Odisha and encourage them to not only become a job seeker but the provider.

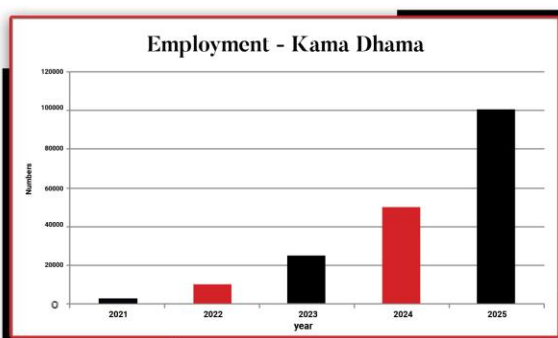
Last year through our Pratishtha program that we started for the disfranchised youths of Jeypore town of Koraput District has seen a magnificent response which led to 100 young boys and girls enrolled. Out of which 80 were selected for the training in the first batch due to resource constraint and 66 are now self-entrepreneurs by starting their own petty businesses and by working in retail stores. Now they are earning INR7K to 15K per month and supporting themselves. Post Fani Cyclone, ORF has also distributed 120 sewing machines to restore back the livelihood opportunities for women from Jalimunda Sahi of Bhubaneswar Slums and Astaranga block of Puri District.

Two Tailoring Training Centres are being undertaken by partnering with Operation Sahay Foundation, Bangalore in Laxmipur and Narayanpatna block of Koraput districts where 60 women are provided with tailoring & embroidery, digital literacy and money management training so that they are self-reliant.

# EMERGENCY - SATARKA

ORF provided immediate relief during the Fani Cyclone in May 2019 to the direct victim of the disaster such as children, women, fisherman, transgender and families.

We directly reached out to more than 4730 families, community members and children from Puri and Khordha districts with the support from our corporate partners and individual donors. Our strategy was to address immediate health needs of the affected families with long term recovery plan and therefore we focused on four components – RELIEF, REHABILITATE, RESTORE & RECOVERY. ORF provided immediate relief kits such as cooked food, dry ration, baby food, clothes, tarpaulin & medicine to the most affected people of Puri and Khorda districts, thereafter we distributed Educational Kits to 1000 children consisting of a bag, water bottle, pens & pencils, notebooks, umbrellas and geometry boxes.



Post Cyclone our focused was on livelihood restoration. We provided 300 sewing machines to SHG members 700 solar lamps to fisherman and 500 tarpaulin for short stay home. Joining our efforts were several other less-affected people who helped us in distribution, sheltered the afflicted masses and made sure we were able to make a significant impact to uplifting the people left deserted in the disaster.

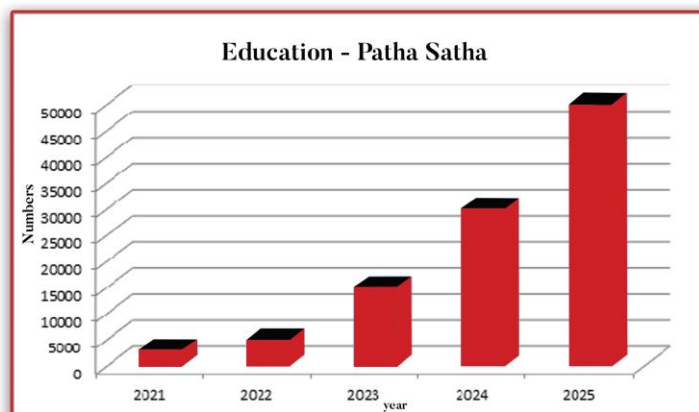

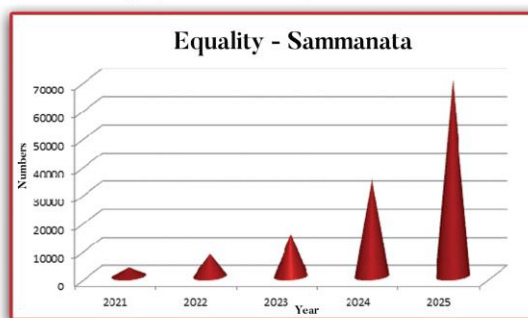

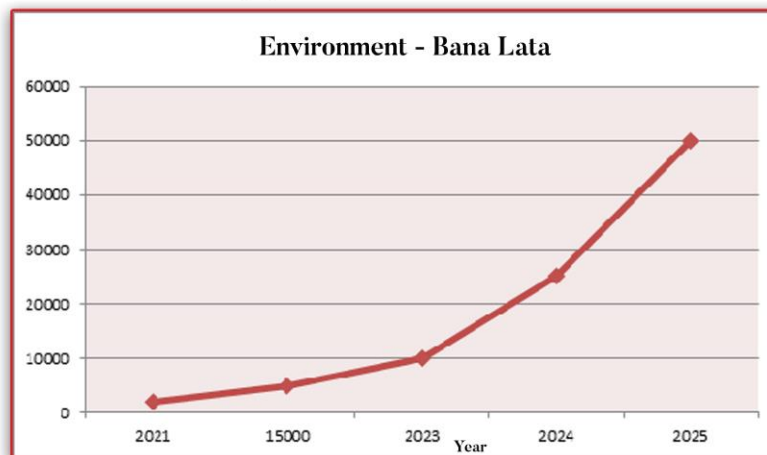

# COVID-19 RELIEF

Several key actions can minimize the risk of transmission of COVID-19 including, washing hands frequently, keeping a distance of at least 1m, wearing a mask and avoiding crowded or close-contact places.

ORF has successfully through its volunteers' network, able to communicate this "new normal" to the most vulnerable communities by creating awareness and by providing immediate relief to those who are in dire need across Odisha. Going forward this will be our most priorities intervention

## ସଫଳତାର କାହାଣୀ

### MITA- A TALE OF UNDYING COURAGE

Mita, 18 years Old young lady is a resident of Jalimunda Sahi, Bhubaneswar. She was given a sewing machine post Fani Cyclone to restore back her livelihood opportunity as she had undergone a tailoring training earlier. With this machine, she started taking small stitching work and thereafter no stopping. Monthly she earns around 5K to 7K which has added more values to their family income.



This helps Mita, getting more respect at home, dignity in her community and financial security for her marriage. Her parents are happy. They can't stop thanking Odisha Rising Foundation for this opportunity.

### PRATIMA- A TALE OF HOPELESS TO HOPEFUL

Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm Fani has wreaked havoc in the coastal districts of Odisha especially in Khordha & Puri, killing more than 40 people. Heavy rainfall and high-speed winds have damaged houses and properties across the city. However the most affected have been the slum dwellers of the capital city who have been rendered homeless .



Among the homeless slum dwellers was Pratima a 45 year old single woman who had a small hut and adjacent to it she had a petty hotel in Jalimunda Sahi. The Fani Cyclonic wave destroyed everything due to which she become helpless and homeless. That was her only income source .

She lost all her belongings including household items, cloths etc. And are in urgent need of food, supplies and other long-term recovery and rehabilitation support to cope with the disaster

ORF while conducting initial need assessment and relief, extended her emergency assistance in the form of food, water, shelter, clothes, domestic items and at the later stage she was helped with house repairing and restoration of her hotel. She is a proud owner of the hotel now serving hot breakfast and meals to hundred people in a day. She got the timely assistance and therefore she is very much thankful to Odisha Rising Foundation & its Team.

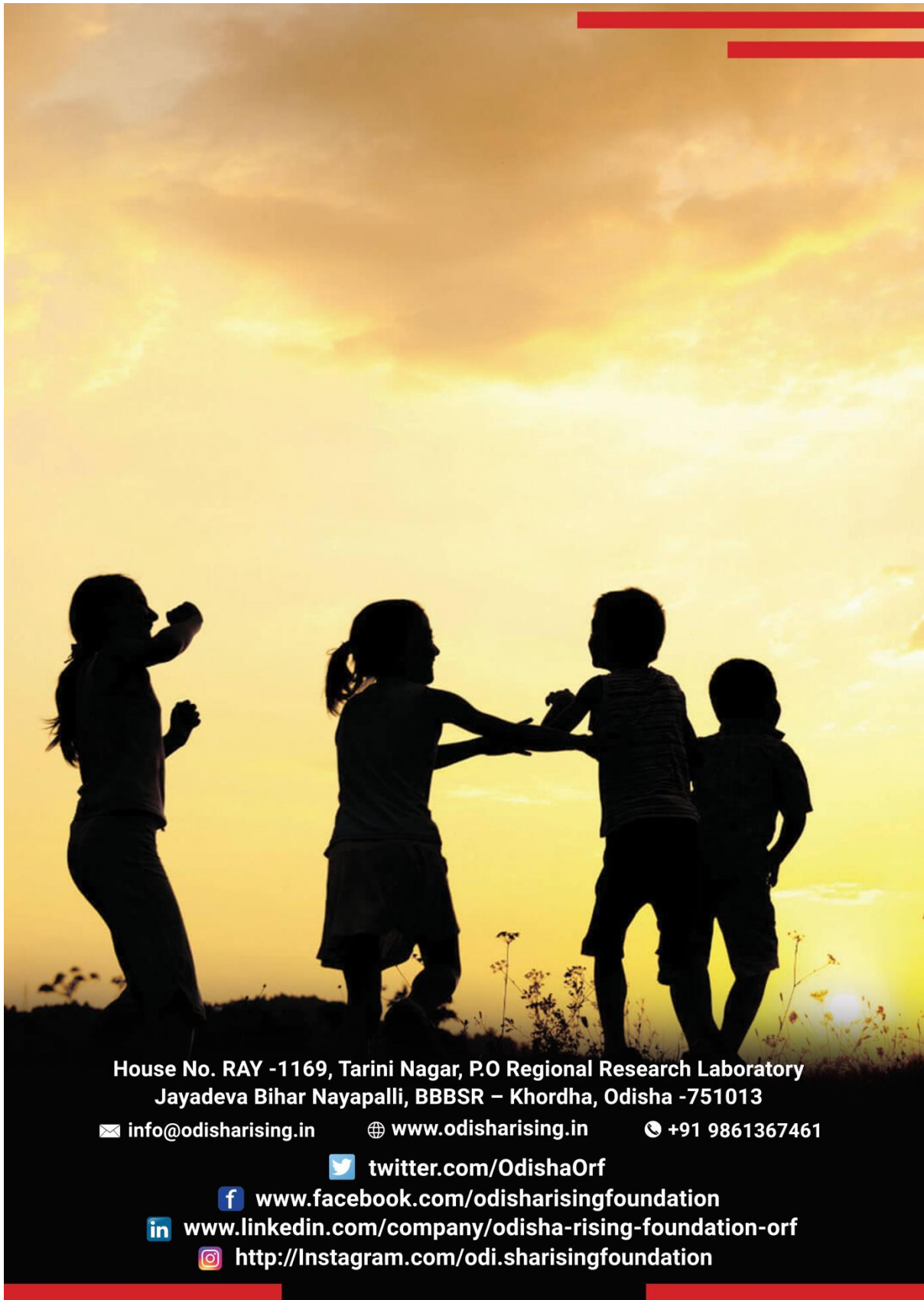
